Standing Committees: *These are committees that always exist—they're always there, "standing" ready deal with issues that come up in that particular area.*

Appropriations: *money set apart for special uses*

Commerce: *business*

Revenue: *money coming in to the government*

Urban: *of the city*

Administration: *running the Legislature's day to day business, including enforcing the Legislature's rules of conduct*
